Peru

New visa requirement for nationals of Mexico

Executive summary

Effective 23 April 2024, nationals of Mexico must obtain a visa prior to entering Peru for business, tourism or to transit through the country.

Key developments

Mexican nationals who seek to enter Peru from this date onward must apply for, and obtain, an entry visa from a Peruvian consulate prior to travel. Applicants must have a passport that is valid for at least 183 days and present other required information and documents (e.g., invitation letter, bank statement), and they may be required to schedule an appointment to appear in person at the consulate.

Mexican nationals will remain exempt from presenting a Peruvian visa provided they have: (1) a valid visa issued by any of the countries comprising the Schengen Area, Canada, the United States of America, Australia, the United Kingdom or Japan, or (2) a valid permanent resident card issued by any of the members of the Pacific Alliance (i.e., Colombia and Chile).

Impact on employers

Employers that deploy Mexican business travelers to Peru may plan accordingly to mitigate business disruptions.
