

# Brazil

New visa requirement for visa nationals transiting through Brazil

## **Executive summary**

Effective 26 August 2024, individuals who require a visa to enter Brazil based on their nationality (i.e., visa nationals) must obtain an entry visa prior to transiting through the country.

#### Key developments

This change impacts all <u>visa nationals</u> transiting through Brazil, irrespective of the duration of their transit through the country. These individuals may apply for a visa at a Brazilian consulate abroad. Previously, these individuals could transit through Brazil without obtaining a visa provided they did not leave the airport transit area.

Individuals who do not require a visa to enter Brazil (i.e., visa-free nationals) are not impacted by this development.

#### Impact on employers

Employers of impacted individuals who transit through Brazil may support their employees with obtaining a visa to ensure compliance and mitigate business disruptions.
